Dear Friends,

Our Prayer Book teaches us that the mission of the Church is to “restore all people to unity with God and each other in Christ.” (BCP 855) At Saint Mary’s we live out this mission through our Worship, Faith Formation, and service to others. Our buildings and grounds are true gifts to serve as a venue to proclaim the Gospel, celebrate the Sacraments, and lovingly serve our neighbors in need.

Buildings and grounds are part of the material aspect of our Christian ministry, as private prayer and public worship consist of the spiritual component of the same. Both the spiritual and material realities of our faith are equally important; we are reminded in the Nicene Creed on Sundays that God made all that is, “seen and unseen.” (BCP 358) Scripture makes clear, all that God made is good. (Gen. 1:31)

This capital campaign looks to renew our parish buildings and grounds, so they may continue to serve as a venue: to Glorify God; provide shelter to those who are homeless during the winter months; welcome our neighbors to know the person of Jesus; and strengthen our faith in Christ as his disciples.

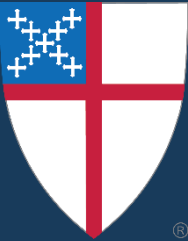

ABOUT ST. MARY'S

St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Hampton Bays, NY is a historic church on Ponquogue Avenue on the way to the beach. It has been said that it is one of the most beautiful small country churches in America. The church has a history of over 100 years of ministry to the Hampton Bays and east end of Long Island communities.

Services are offered in both English and Spanish and are held Wednesdays and Sundays at 9 am, as well as Thursday and Saturday evenings.

The church sponsors programs for the homeless, the hungry, families of prisoners, young people and meets special needs as they arise. We provide space for regular meetings of 12-step programs such as AA. Our friendly congregation holds various events throughout the year, the Christmas Fair, a Wine Tasting, a Community Yard Sale, the Blessing of the Animals and the Blessing of the Bikes (Motorcycles) as well as coffee hours after Sunday and Thursday services weekly, and Wednesday healing service weekly, on-going Bible studies, men's, women's and young family fellowship groups.

St. Mary's welcomes everyone from all walks of life and many religious backgrounds. It is a great church where anyone can worship and learn about God while making new friends and serving those in need.

WHY A CAPITAL CAMPAIGN?

We have been blessed with our beautiful church buildings. They not only serve our congregation but the community at large. Most of our buildings require updating and repair to meet today's needs.

CAMPAIGN PROJECTS

Technology UpgradesCOMPLETED\$10,500

The church has upgraded our technology, including new computer systems, laptops, increased WIFI and broadcast ability in the Fireside Room and Church, plus a projector for presentations.

Sacristy RenovationIN PROGRESS\$20,000

A restricted gift will make our sacristy more efficient for our altar guild to prepare for worship services.

Door, Door Frame Replacement & Gutter Expansion\$25,000

Repair or replacement of two doors and a window on the south side of the parish hall, plus gutters where lacking.

The Organ\$60,000

Major renovation or replacement, with work completed in phases as needed.

Roof Repairs\$20,000

The Church roof was repaired for roughly \$3,000; the balance will remain available for other roof repairs.

Air Conditioning\$108,500

Engineering study completed. Two new HVAC units are recommended to air-condition and heat the Church more efficiently.

Parking LotsCOMPLETED\$6,000

Sealed and repainted.

Outside LightingCOMPLETED\$18,000

Dark skies friendly lighting installed over front sidewalks and rear parking lot for improved security and safety.

Property Development\$20,000

Explore the best use of nearly seven acres of land, including three potential building lots north of the rectory.

Campaign Expenses\$9,000

Budgeted cost of the Capital Campaign.

SignageCOMPLETED\$320

The sign next to the office door as well as the shield over the parish hall entrance have been replaced
